In Chiapas, they have registered 723 orchid species, which is 60% of the species in the country. The species is among the most evolved plant family because of its sophisticated mechanisms that ensure pollination.

The expert explained that the orchids are one of the most diverse and rich families. They are divided into two types: terrestrial and epiphytes. Terrestrial orchids are grown on earth and epiphyte orchids grow on trees, stones, or sticks. In Chiapas, around 200 species are terrestrial and 500 other species are epiphytes.

Unfortunately, all these richness of orchids are in danger of extinction, said the expert, who demanded that the authorities take “strong actions in favor of the environment before the spaces where the enigmatic orchids live end up deforested and make room for a kind of desert.”
